REFERENCE LETTER'S

Please have **THREE (3)** people **NOT RELATED** to you and **ONE (1)** family member send us a letter of recommendation on your behalf for your adoption. This letter must be mailed directly to All for Love Adoptions, Inc. from the writer and **be original, not a copy**. It is not acceptable for them to give you the letter and have you send it to All for Love Adoptions. Please have them answer the following questions in their reference letter.

1. How long have you known these individuals? What is your relationship with them (close friends, acquaintances, work associates, etc.)?
2. What do you like best about him? What are his strengths and weaknesses?
3. What do you like best about her? What are her strengths and weaknesses?
4. How would you describe their marriage? Have you seen them resolve conflicts? If yes please elaborate.
5. How do they relate with children?
6. Would the addition of an adopted child of any ethnicity be a positive experience for this family and why would you recommend them as adoptive parents?
7. Does this family have any other children in the home, and if so how do you feel they will respond to a new sibling?
